1 MORE TRAINING INSTITUTIONS GET ECSACOP ACCREDITATION

The accreditation exercise was led by the Vice Chairperson of the ECSACOP Accreditation Committee Dr. Tapiwa Bwakura.

The site inspection exercise involved verification of resources to support the clinical training program in accordance to the ECSACOP curriculum.

An accredited training site will provide ECSACOP trainees with the opportunity to improve on their clinical skills and knowledge and ensure quality supervision during the training process.

ECSACOP training sites are assessed against a set of standards that have been identified by the College, which set out to ensure that a minimum standard of facilities and ECSACOP Clinical supervisors are available to support the delivery of training and the needs of trainees.
